RESEARCH INTERESTS

My area of specialisation is the material and visual culture of Korea from pre-modern till contemporary times. Much of my work has centred on the Koryŏ [Goryeo] kingdom (AD918-1392), in particular the overlap between secular and mortuary uses of ceramics and metal wares. More recently my research on Koryŏ archaeological material has led to explorations of how Koryŏ tomb objects were given new meanings and identities by early twentieth century collectors. Another research strand is that of modern and contemporary Korean art, where I address the cultural, social and political trajectories underpinning artists' responses to a rapidly changing peninsula.
